Statement of Intent for Modern Foreign Languages (MFL) at Bickleigh Down (CE Aided) Primary School

In our provision of Modern Foreign Languages (MFL) at Bickleigh Down Primary, we aim to ensure that all of our pupils are given the opportunity to deepen their understanding of the world around them and expand their knowledge of other cultures.

In Key Stage Two, the MFL curriculum will enable children to express their ideas in French and to understand and respond to speakers of the language. Children will be given the opportunity to communicate in French for practical purposes and develop these skills with increasing confidence. Throughout their learning of MFL, children will be encouraged to ask questions, develop and improve their pronunciation and write using grammatical structures that they have learnt.

By the end of Key Stage Two, children will be able to:

- Show understanding of spoken French by joining in and responding
- Express an opinion in French and respond to guestions from others
- Develop knowledge of familiar vocabulary and speak in sentences using phrases and basic language structure
- Develop accuracy in pronunciation when reading aloud
- Show understanding of simple French text within rhymes, songs and stories
- Use key French phrases to describe people, places and things
- Understand basic French grammar and key features of the language
