Progress 2022

A school's progress scores in English reading, English writing and mathematics are calculated as the average of its pupils' subject progress scores. These scores give an indication of whether, as a group, pupils in the school made above or below average progress in a subject compared with pupils with similar starting points nationally. Schools are then allocated three progress scores for Reading, Writing and Mathematics. A score of 0 means pupils in this school, on average, do about as well at Key Stage Two as those with similar prior attainment nationally.
